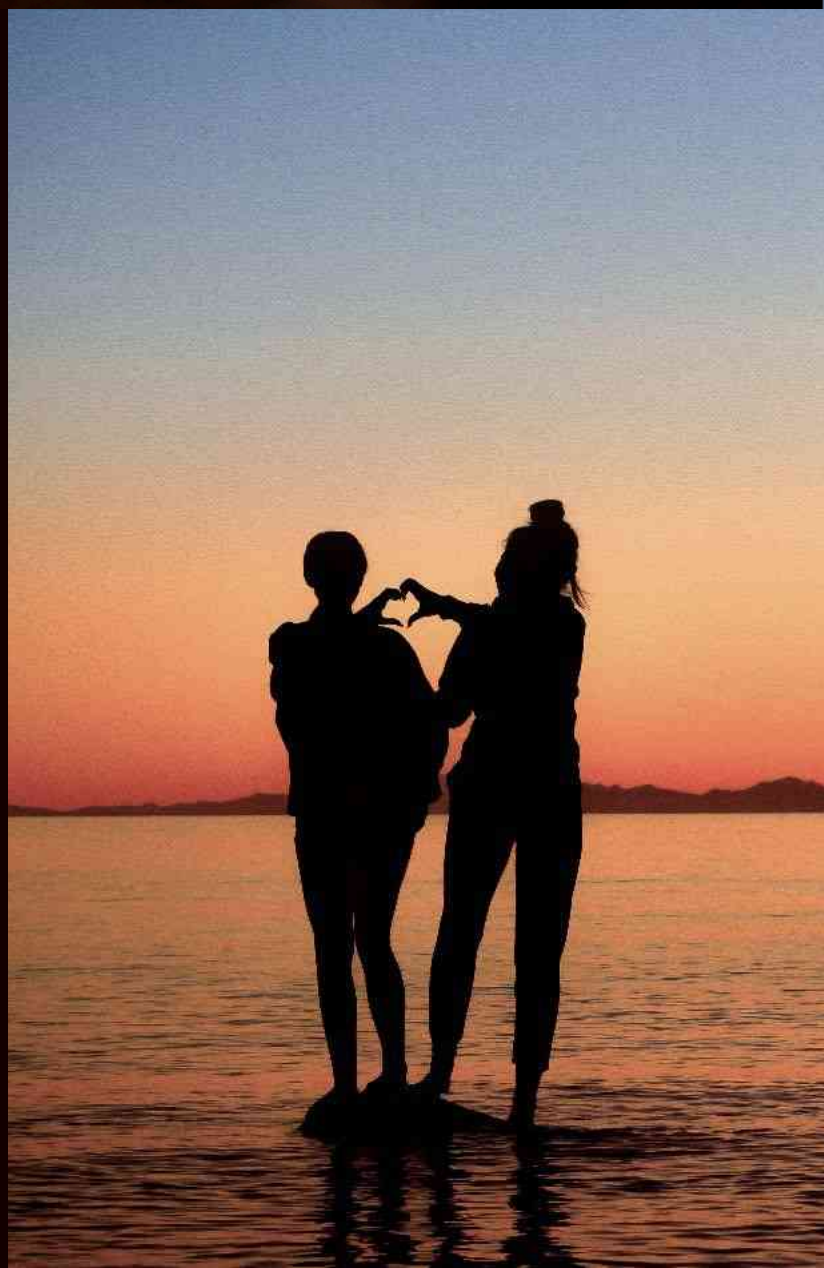
Thank you for taking action to protect our sea, and for inspiring others to do the same!

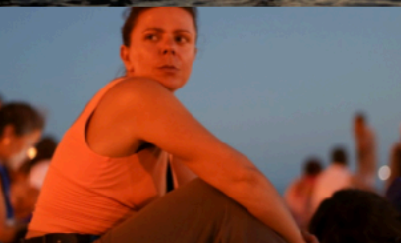
## Decorate with natural materials
